**David Mosscrop won the Open B Class against 5 from Sask, 5 from Alberta and 2 Manitoba.**

**On reporting the above results this appears to be a good time to provide some information on the assistance provided to athletes representing Manitoba at other competitions.**

**Our programs provide for two levels of assistance.**

**The first is from the MTA and assists Manitoba Champions to train and attend National and International championships events, In the case where the champions cannot or do not attend consideration is given to runner ups, class winner's and possibly to the 1 st all star team if they attend. The amount available will depend on the funding, the number of athletes requesting funding. The funding is on the basis of the decision by the Board of Directors and all athletes that are being considered must complete and sign the athlete assistance form and submit it to the Secretary Treasurer for board consideration. The funding for these programs is set up in the late part of the year and the over all budget approved in February by Sport Manitoba. The funding window is from April 1 to March 31 the following year.**

**The second level of funding is from Sport Manitoba and direct athlete funding and is for Provincial Champions only and they must attend a National or International championship. Some latitude is given in the case of Juniors and Sub Juniors to attend other championships. Champions that have attended a national or international championship and report it to the MTA are sent a Sport Manitoba Form for completion. Upon completion and return to the MTA secretary this form is submitted for consideration to Sport Manitoba. The amounts under this program can range up to \$ 1000 depending on competition and results.**

**The copy of the program book and the policy and procedures has been uploaded to the MTA web site and can be down loaded by all shooters. You probably will want to have a high speed line hook up for this job.**
